WINEMAKER NOTES

All Hundred Acre wines are made by sorting the fruit berry by berry, fermenting in small, French oak fermenters, and long aging in the finest barriques. The secret to Hundred Acre is no compromise and no detail overlooked, ever.

VINEYARD NOTES

Morgan's Way was the very first vineyard I started to farm with my dear friend Jim Barbour in 2000. She, (I call her she because power and elegance in a bottle is most certainly feminine), is an ancient clay mixed with volcanic pebbles and black obsidian glass scattered here and there from the eruption of Mt. St. Helena, many eons ago. The ancient clay is rich in minerals and as it dries out, it cracks in the summer, allowing the vines roots to go deep for the cool water underground, trapped in the old clay and helps the vines resist heat.

VINTAGE NOTES

The 2022 growing season was truly special, with plenty of winter rain to fill our reservoirs, and abundant sunshine and heat through the summer months. An unusual late season rain washed the dust off the berries, starting a gentle cooling trend that set us up perfectly for the final ripening push in the Fall. We hang fruit on the vine longer than most, and the weather conditions in 2022 allowed us time to push that envelope to the limit, resulting in wines with an intense fruit expression, and a full-bodied core.

APPELLATION

Napa Valley

VARIETAL

100% Cabernet Sauvignon

COOPERAGE

Aged for 34 months in 100% new French oak (10% in 500L puncheons). We use the finest, center cut French oak barrique with stave wood hand-selected for ultra-tight grain, then air dried for three years before being made into barrels.

TASTING NOTES

A captivating oenological triumph. Waves of red and black fruit mingle with warm brioche and vanilla, and a subtle touch of black pepper. The aromatics evolve with each sip, revealing saddle leather, a note of crushed limestone, and hints of dried herbs. The palate is both rich and inviting, combining delightful earth, fruit, and spice elements with each new sip. Expansive and soft, the texture of the wine is enhanced by a velvet tannin structure that carries with it flavors of dark cherry and blackberry. The beautifully refined finish is smooth and lingering, leaving a lasting impression of elegance and depth.
